Please find attached the Court's opinion issued today in the above referenced cause.

Under Rule 48.4, an attorney representing a defendant in a criminal appeal shall, within five days after the opinion is handed down, send his client a copy of the opinion and judgment, along with notification of the defendant's right to file a pro se petition for discretionary review under Rule 68. This notification shall be sent certified mail, return receipt requested, to the defendant at his last known address. The attorney shall also send the court of appeals a letter certifying compliance with this rule and attaching a copy of the return receipt within the time for filing a motion for rehearing.

TEX. R. APP. P. 48.4. The Court will file the letter in the record of the appeal. *Id.*

The letter certifying compliance must be filed via eFile Texas.
