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II. Nature of Case

Offense: Possession of Controlled Substance, Penalty Group 1 (4–200 grams), second-degree felony, Deferred Adjudication dismissed October 23, 2024 (EXH-001).

Disposition Appealed: Verbal rulings on May 19, 2025, including:

Reinstating probation without jurisdiction (EXH-013)

Coercing a “not true” plea via pass slip lacking allegations (EXH-013, Exhibit O)

Denying appellate counsel (EXH-013, Exhibit M).d. Failing to rule on March 19–20, 2025, motions by May 1, 2025, deadline (EXH-008, EXH-010, EXH-012). No written order issued; no “May 1, 2025, order” exists (EXH-012).

Plea: Not true, signed on pass slip May 19, 2025 (Exhibit O).

Punishment: Probation unlawfully reinstated May 19–June 23, 2025 (EXH-013). No amended MTA was provided as of June 18, 2025 (Exhibit M). MTA hearing set for June 23, 2025, with emergency stay motion filed June 22, 2025.

III. Dates

Date of Judgment/Order: May 19, 2025 (verbal rulings).

Date of Sentence: May 19, 2025 (probation reinstatement).

Motion for New Trial: None filed due to lack of counsel, notice, and jurisdiction (EXH-013, Exhibit M).

Notice of Appeal: June 16, 2025.

Timeliness: Filed within 30 days of May 19, 2025; equitable tolling applies due to lack of notice and counsel (EXH-013, Exhibit M; *Holland v. Florida*, 560 U.S. 631 (2010)).

IV. Record

Clerk’s Record: Requested, including all filings (EXH-000–EXH-014, Exhibits E, L, M, N, O).

Reporter’s Record: Requested for hearings on May 19, 2025, and June 18, 2025 (Exhibits E, M).

Indigency: Costs waived due to indigency (EXH-000; Tex. Code Crim. Proc. Art. 1.051(d)).

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V. Issues Likely to Be Raised

1. Lack of Jurisdiction: Trial court lacked jurisdiction post-October 23, 2024, dismissal (EXH-001; Tex. Code Crim. Proc. Art. 42A.103(a); Ex parte White, 506 S.W.3d 39 (Tex. Crim. App. 2016)).
2. Due Process Violations: No notice or hearing for vacatur (EXH-002, EXH-004, EXH-007); 67-day detention without magistrate hearing (EXH-000, EXH-005); no amended MTA served (EXH-004, Exhibit M); coerced plea via pass slip (EXH-013, Exhibit O; Mullane v. Central Hanover Bank, 339 U.S. 306 (1950); Boykin v. Alabama, 395 U.S. 238 (1969)).
3. Sixth Amendment Violations: Denial of appellate counsel (EXH-010, EXH-013, Exhibit M); ineffective assistance by Maria Tu (EXH-013, EXH-014, Exhibit O; Gideon v. Wainwright, 372 U.S. 335 (1963); Strickland v. Washington, 466 U.S. 668 (1984)).

VI. Other Information

Bond Status: \$750 cash bond imposed February 13–May 19, 2025 (EXH-006).
Related Appeals: Concurrent Original Petition for Writ of Mandamus, Cause No. 05-25-00731-CR, filed June 22, 2025.
Supersedeas: Emergency Motion for Stay of June 23, 2025, MTA hearing filed June 22, 2025.
